

## BLOOD WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE FORM

- 1) Officer placed suspect under arrest for a Chapter 49 offense involving operation of a motor vehicle.
- 2) Officer read DIC-24 to suspect and provided suspect with written copy.
- 3) Suspect \_\_\_ did consent \_\_\_ refused request to give blood sample (mandatory) \_\_\_ unconscious or incapable of refusal. (check one)
- 4) Officer \_\_\_ provided vial \_\_\_ used vial provided by hospital. (check one)
- 5) Expiration date on blood kit/vial is \_\_\_\_\_.
- 6) Officer did fill out label that came with kit completely except for the time blood was drawn.
- 7) Preservative/anti-coagulant powder was seen in vial.
- 8) Nurse/technician did the following in withdrawing blood from subject:
  - Used betadine (or other: \_\_\_\_\_) non isopropanol solution to disinfect arm.
  - Officer saved swab packaging.
  - Rotate/Invert vial 8 times so as to mix blood with preservative anti-coagulant.
- 9) Vial (top never having been opened) was then delivered to officer and officer completed label with time of blood draw and officer and nurse/technician initials.
