BOND CONDITIONS

Pursuant to Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 17.40, the court finds that certain bond conditions related to the safety of the victim of the alleged offense and/or the safety of the community will secure the defendant's attendance at trial. In addition to other conditions required by the bond itself, the court imposes the bond conditions indicated below by an "x" or " $\sqrt{}$ " as follows:

_____1. Do not commit any offense against the laws of this state, any other state, or the United States.

_____ 2. Do not use, possess or consume marihuana or any controlled substance, narcotic, or dangerous drug unless prescribed lawfully by a physician.

_____ 3. Do not initiate any communications with _______ or any household member of said individual, and do not go within ______ yards of said individual, any household member of said individual, or the residence or work address of said individual.

____4. (a) Within 30 days of your release from jail, install at your expense an ignition interlock device on your vehicle (or on the vehicle most regularly driven by you) that uses a deep-lung breath analysis mechanism to make impractical the operation of a motor vehicle if ethyl alcohol is detected in the breath of the operator; (b) Do not operate any motor vehicle unless the vehicle is equipped with such a device. (This bond condition is **mandatory** pursuant to CCP Art. 17.441 for persons accused of **DWI 2nd**, **DWI 3rd**, **Intoxication Assault, and Intoxication Manslaughter** <u>unless</u> the magistrate finds that requiring the device would not be in the best interests of justice.)

_____ 5. Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character, including any place alcoholic beverages are sold for "on premises" consumption except for restaurants where food is prepared on site.

_____ 6. Report to the Wilbarger County Community Supervision Office as directed by a Probation Officer and submit to and pay for random urine specimen analysis tests at the Community Supervision Office, 1700 Wilbarger Street, Vernon, TX 76384, (940) 552-2702.

_____7. **Curfew.** Be at your residence by ______ p.m. and remain there until ______a.m. except when at work or on a direct route going to or from work.

____8. Pursuant to CCP Art. 17.47, submit a DNA sample to the Wilbarger County Sheriff's Department prior to your release from custody. (**Mandatory** for Aggravated Kidnapping (by inflicting bodily injury or violating or abusing sexually), Indecency with a Child, Sexual Assault, Aggravated Sexual Assault, Prohibited Sexual Conduct, Burglary of a Habitation (with intent to commit a felony other than theft), Compelling Prostitution, Sexual Performance by a Child, or Possession of Promotion of Child Pornography).

Special Order(s) (Below)

This order is effective immediately and shall continue in effect until modified by order of this court or another court.

If you violate this order your bond may be forfeited, revoked, or increased, and you may be subject to confinement until the conclusion of the criminal case against you. Additionally, you may be punished for contempt of court by a fine of \$100.00 or by confinement in jail for as long as three days or both.
