

CAREER INVESTIGATOR AWARD

This is an alternative to the Lifetime Achievement Award (described below). This Award is to recognize an Investigator who is retiring and has given of themselves to the Association and the profession of Prosecutor's Investigator, worked with and for the goals of the Association, and who has spent a considerable amount of time as a DA/CA Investigator. The difference between this award and the Lifetime Achievement Award is other than a plaque, there would be no cost to the Association. This award is given only at the Investigator's Conference in February. Written nominations detailing their contributions, accomplishments, responsibilities and dedication must be submitted to the Ex Officio of the Investigator section board. Nominations are accepted throughout the year. The applicant will meet the following criteria:

1. Obtained his or her PCI Certificate
2. Ten (10) years of TDCAA membership (may be cumulative but not broken more than 10 years)
3. Retiring after 15 years of service as a Prosecutor's Investigator with at least 20 years as a sworn Texas Peace Officer.
