COMES NOW the State of Texas, by and through her Assistant County Attorney and does hereby request this Court to issue an order to the Texas Department of Public Safety to go to Cedar Park Wrecker Service at 13300 Wire Road, Texas, located in Travis County, Texas and to locate a 2004 Silver Pontiac Grand Am with VIN Number 1G2NF52E14C216152 and plate number GCL 0051 for the purpose of retrieving data from a recording device which is installed within this vehicle and for good cause would show the following:

I.

The Texas Department of Public Safety is investigating a motor vehicle collision that occurred on or about August 25, 2015, in Williamson County, Texas. One of the vehicles involved in this collision was a 2004 Silver Pontiac Grand Am with VIN Number 1G2NF52E14C216152 and plate number GCL 0051. This vehicle is registered to Veronica Valenzuela Rodriguez. At the time of the collision, the vehicle was driven by Jose Palomo Valenzuela. The vehicle is at Cedar Park Wrecker Service and is currently located at 13300 Wire Road, Cedar Park, Texas, and remains at this location as of the making of this application. Due to the information that has been compiled by the investigating officers, there is reasonable belief that this collision constitutes a criminal offense.

The investigating officers have determined that this vehicle has a device commonly called an airbag / electronic control module that was installed by the manufacturer that may record certain data, including, but not limited to:

- (1) The speed the vehicle was traveling for five seconds prior to algorithm enable.
- (2) Engine Cycle Revolutions Per Minute for five seconds prior to algorithm enable.
- (3) Engine throttle pressure for five seconds prior to algorithm enable.
- (4) Braking information for five seconds prior to algorithm enable.
- (5) The driver's safety belt status.
- (6) Ignition cycles of the vehicle.
- (7) Change in velocity after algorithm enable.

This information is transmitted to a central communications system.

The information that is contained in the recording device and which is sought by the State is evidence of the offense (s) of Intoxication Assault: and constitutes evidence that Jose Palomo Valenzuela committed the offense (s) of Intoxication Assault, Aggravated Assault with Deadly Weapon.

This application is sought under the authority of Section 547.615 of the Texas Transportation Code.

- (6) Ignition cycles of the vehicle.
- (7) Change in velocity after algorithm enable.
