SEARCH WARRANT

The State of TEXAS: To the Sheriff or any Peace Officer of Harris County, State of Texas, or any Peace Officer of the State of Texas:

Whereas, the affiant whose name appears on the affidavit attached hereto is a peace officer under the laws of **Texas** and did heretofore this day subscribe and swear to said affidavit before me, and whereas I find that the verified facts stated by affiant in said affidavit show that affiant has probable cause for the belief he/she expresses herein and establishes existence of proper grounds for issuance of this Warrant;

Now, therefore, you are commanded to search the suspected persons, place, vehicles, and premises described in said affidavit, as follows:

65 Terry Hall Lane. It is a two- story, brown wood townhouse within a townhouse community known as Watkins Glenn Townhomes. Terry Lane is a street that runs off of Evergreen Blvd. It is the entry into Watkins Glenn. You go south on Terry Hall for about ¼ mile and you come to a stop sign. You turn right (west) at the stop sign, which is still Terry Hall Lane, and go about 100 yards. You turn left (south) and on the right hand side is a large two-story wooden structure with multiple dwellings. There are four townhouse units facing the street, which is still named Terry Hall Lane. #65 is the last unit on the north end of the building. The front door as copper numbers 65 affixed to it. It is located within the city of Houston, and within Harris County, Texas.

The suspected place includes the entire premises and curtilage at that location, if a residence, including all outbuildings, sheds, and vehicles found to be under the control of the persons described below in which evidence sought under this warrant could reasonably be hidden. The suspected place is in control of: **Robert Hammonds, a white male, DOB: 3/19/52.**

At said places you shall search for and, if same be found, seize and bring before me the property described in the affidavit, as follows:

Property the possession of which is prohibited by law, namely, images of child pornography, either printed or digitally stored on the hard drives of computers, external hard drives, other external storage devices including, but not limited to CD's, DVD's, external hard drives, thumb drives, floppy disks, Zip drives, and memory cards including SCANDISK and COMPACT Flash Cards, cellular telephones and digital cameras. Also, instruments used in the commission of the offense of possession of child pornography namely, any cameras, digital or film type, and any memory cards for said cameras.

Herein fail not, but have you then and there this Warrant, within ten (10) whole days of the issuance of the warrant, exclusive of the day of its issuance and of the day of its execution, and then return the warrant and show how you have executed this Warrant.
